

Obituary – William John Waldwyn

Retired member Bill Waldwyn died on 11th February 2014 aged 85. Bill joined the Air Ministry Constabulary at an early age serving most of his police career spanning nearly 40 years at Malvern, Worcestershire.

During his service Bill carried out detached duties at many stations across the country including Scotland and Northern Ireland.

While at Malvern he was for a time Secretary of the Police Social Club helping to arrange a variety of social functions and charity events.

Upon retirement from the MDP in 1987 Bill joined the ROA and served for many years as a Committee member. He held the distinction of attending every reunion from 1987 to 2013 except in the year 2010 when his late wife Gladys was ill. Sadly Gladys passed away shortly afterwards.
