CLIVE MUNDY

It is with regret that the death of retired officer Clive Mundy is announced.

Clive died on 2nd April 2016 aged 82 years. He began his police career with the Air Ministry Constabulary in 1954 after a period of National Service with the RAF.

The Force was renamed Air Force Departmental Constabulary in 1964, by which time Clive was stationed at Fylingdales in North Yorkshire. He later gained promotion to Sergeant while continuing to serve at Fylingdales until 1980.

Clive then transferred to Stafford on promotion to Inspector then latterly served at Cold Meece, Stone, Staffordshire where he retired from the MDP in 1989.

Clive's funeral service will be held 3pm Monday 18th April at Stafford Crematorium.
